

CARTERS LAKE CAMPGROUND RULES

Quiet hours are in effect from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

The campground entrance gate will be locked at 10:00 p.m. and opened at 9:00 a.m. Campers may exit the park at any time by using the electronic gate. No camper vehicles are permitted to re-enter the park after 10:00 p.m.

Campers must display a camping permit at numbered campsite marker.

All pets must be penned, caged, or on a leash no longer than six feet. Vicious pets are not allowed.

Protect natural resources by hanging lanterns on holders and using only dead wood for campfires.

Please keep campsites clean. Pick up litter prior to checking out and deposit all garbage in the dumpster located in the park.

Swimmers should use extreme caution, beware of sudden drops and deep water. All swimming is at your own risk.

For complete regulations see the campground bulletin board or ask the Park Attendant for a copy of Title 36.

Woodring Branch Campground Information

Woodring Branch Campground has 42 campsites. Thirty-one sites have electric and water hookups, the remaining 11 sites are tent only campsites. Campers may reserve campsites by calling the campground at 706-276-6050 or the National Recreation Reservation Service at 877-444-6777 or on the web site at www.recreation.gov.

Campers may utilize a comfort station furnished with showers and laundry facilities. Other facilities include a playground, swimming area, and horseshoe pits. Boats may launch from a boat ramp within the park.

Woodring Branch Campground is open from early April through late October.
